Announcements and Upcoming GHC Events

Update on Advocacy Efforts:



After overcoming delays, MSO, GHC, and Chamber met with NPS for Salute to Independence discussions. New NPS policies for events on national park property will be officially implemented in January. While the meeting covered event components like logistics, portable bathrooms, and safety measures, specific NPS requirements remain unknown until MSO submits a formal application to hold the event at Antietam and NPS can review their request.

Notably, NPS will no longer cover event expenses, requiring MSO to cover or reimburse \$25-\$30k of in-kind support. Despite expressing commitment to a 2024 event, internal discussions suggest 2024 is unlikely due to logistical constraints and existing commitments with HCC. MSO plans to submit an application in the coming weeks and go through the NPS review process. Internal planning leans toward another year at HCC in 2024, with a potential return to the Battlefield in 2025, contingent on logistics and funding.


