





Maryland Legislative Update

2024 Session Review

John F. Favazza, Manis Canning & Associates May 31, 2024

The Backdrop

- Governor Moore and Legislative Leadership, Year Two
- General Fund and Transportation Trust Fund Shortfalls
- It's an Election Year...
- Bills, Bills, and More Bills!

Operating Budget Summary

- \$761 Million Budget Shortfall Projected for FY 2025, growing to \$1.3 Billion by FY 2027
- \$255 Million March Revenue Write-down
- House Dedicated nearly \$500 Million in New Revenue to Blueprint For Maryland's Future
- Final Budget Compromise Includes Only a Tobacco Tax Increase Along With Fund Balance and Reserves Transfers

Transportation Summary

- \$3.3 Billion Transportation Trust Fund Shortfall
- House proposed a \$750 Million Package, Including an EV Owner Surcharge, a Rideshare Fee, a Vehicle Excise Tax Increase, and Increases to Existing Vehicle Registration Fees
- Final Compromise resulted in \$252 Million in New Transportation Revenue and continuation of the TRAIN Commission


